

# Old Monkland & Coltswood Cemetery Annual Remembrance Services

Please join us at this year's annual remembrance services in Old Monkland Cemetery on Sunday 5th November at 2.00pm and at Coltswood Cemetery on Sunday 26th November at 2pm.

31st Sunday, A Reflection. Malachi attacks the laxity and carelessness that have set in regarding morality and worship. He rebukes the religious leaders for not living up to their calling, and thus being responsible for the erosion of faith among people.

In the Gospel Jesus strongly criticises those who use religion to gain spiritual power, and who do not live what is at the heart of religion: love and compassion, justice and faith. Our religiosity can just be an empty external cloak, an empty show, to attract attention and honour to ourselves. Internally, we can be so full of our importance that there is no place for God in our hearts.

Today there is great emphasis on appearances. The image is more important than the reality. We may deceive others but we cannot deceive God. But then it would be foolish even to try. We don't have to put an outward show, or pretend to be what we are not. All we have to do is try to be true to what we are-God's son and daughters.

## **Project Wellspring: from Bishop Toal**

I am pleased to announce that we have very recently launched a new renewal project entitled Wellspring which seeks to equip the Diocese of Motherwell for growth over the next 10 years. The primary focus of this new project will be to renew and re-energise our missions by setting-out a simple Gospel-centred vision and a fresh, new pastoral plan. It will also include a strategy for property and finance management.

We are already engaged in the early stages of planning with the clergy, supported by a small team of unpaid lay professionals who will manage the process with us. The discussion phases will very soon engage parishes and laity so that we can all contribute to the important work of preparing for the future. I expect to engage the entire diocesan community, young and old, as we move into 2024.

I am excited at the prospect of setting a new course as we look ahead with confidence to the next 10 years of mission in our diocese. Please pray that Wellspring will indeed be a great gift that renews and strengthens our bonds with the Lord and His Church. Pray, too, that it inspires our sisters and brothers who have distanced themselves to reengage with the regular practice of our Catholic Faith.

May Our Lady of Good Aid, our patroness and Mother, crown our work with her grace.
