3rd Sunday of Lent B -

Our celebration of Lent is not simply an attempt to improve our behaviour. It is rather a quest to renew our heart. At the level of heart, where we feel, where we understand, where we believe, there we meet the Lord, and there the Lord changes us.

So, our prayer in important because it feeds our spirit. Our reflection on the thing of God is important, because it helps us understand ourselves, our actions and our words. Our attentiveness to the Word of God makes us aware of God amongst us.

We want to engage in acts of reconciliation, we wish to be committed to humanitarian action, helping our neighbours in their need; we would burn with zeal for justice, we intend to be full of reverence for God and for the things of God. We are eager to undo the wrongs of the past by the good deeds of the present. All because the Lord is within us and among us, renewing us in heart.

Lenten Retreat for First Communicants

Thanks to the families who took the time to come along to our Lenten Retreat to help their child prepare for the Sacrament of First Holy Communion.

When was the last time you went to Confession?

Lent is the perfect time to return to the sacrament of confession. How? It is so simple

1) Make a thorough examination of conscience by reflecting on sin in your life.

2) Begin with the sign of the cross & by saying, "Bless me father for I have sinned. It has been [time] since my last confession...These are my sins.." and begin stating your sins.

3) The priest will give you your penance (something to do or pray after your Confession). This is an act of repentance in response to God's Mercy in the confessional.

4) The priest will ask you to pray the Act of Contrition out loud as to proclaim your sorrow for your sins.

5) The priest will extend his hands and pray the Prayer of Absolution. Your response is: 'AMEN'.

6) The priest will then likely give a final blessing like:

"God has freed you from your sins. Go in peace."
