#### **Prayer for Belarus**

We will all have heard about the troubles in Belarus following the recent disputed election let us pray for peace, forgiveness and justice for Belarus at this difficult time.

#### **Church Refurbishment**

The present COVID19 situation has affected everyone financially and this also includes the church. Parish bills still require to be paid as well as our desire to refurbish our church in order to restore it to its former glory. The plans will in the very near future be put forward for approval by the dioceses at an estimated cost of £120,000. The breakdown of these works are as follows:-

- The removal of the screen and the reinstatement of the former sanctuary and altar steps. All associated joinery and building works. Estimated costs - £15,000
- Electrical Works. Upgrade of the mains distribution board, rewiring, new sockets and lighting, emergency lighting and the PA system etc. Estimated costs - £30,000
- Floorcoverings. New sanctuary carpet and Repairs to the existing parquet flooring. Estimated costs - £15,000

- Redecoration package including the sanctuary and the nave plus scaffolding and access costs.
   Estimated costs- £25,000
- 5. Contingency Costs for items 1 -4 @10%. Estimated Costs £8,500
- 6. VAT on items 1 to 5 @ 20%. Estimated Cost £18,700
- 7. Professional fees for Architect and Designer including VAT. Estimated Costs £6,000

Total Estimated cost £118,200, rounded up to £120,000



All practical initiatives to raise funds are to be encouraged. The church refurbishment will be a significant financial undertaking for the parish. If you are able to make a separate donation at masses, please place the donation in an envelope indicating that it is for the building fund. This will run in conjunction with existing fundraising activities such as the 500 Club, the money jars and the Sponsor a Tile initiative.

Due to COVID 19 the church has lost a significant amount of income, so we aim to minimise other collections in order for us to focus on the church refurbishment. It is planned that on the first Sunday of every month there will be a special collection for the building fund and the first one will take place on the weekend of the 5th/6th September.
