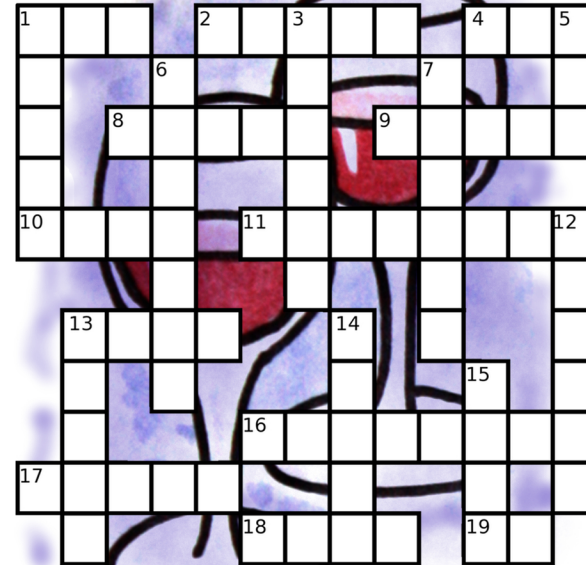
# SAINT SEBASTIAN
