

#### 3rd Sunday of the Year B

We hear the call of Peter, Andrew, James and John. They left everything and followed Jesus. It wasn't that they were fed up with fishing- fishing was an important occupation. They knew Jesus was calling them to do something more worthwhile with their lives. The Lord still calls people today. And there are still those who respond. Some people like the four apostles are called to dedicate themselves totally to the following of Christ. Most importantly, we are all called to be Christian where we are and in our chosen occupation or profession.

Too many people today do the kind of work they don't like to do. Instead of choosing their jobs freely, they are forced by economic necessity to work at tasks that fail to satisfy them.
