

Reflection: 2nd Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy) B

Loneliness is a major complaint today. We need community; we need a support system to sustain our faith, hope and love. We need a small group, in order to be able to survive. But our parishes have become so large and so anonymous.

Here we see the fruits of the community, a bonding, sharing, community of togetherness. God doesn't mean us to do it alone. So, we shouldn't be afraid to immerse ourselves in a supportive community. Perhaps what we need is a network of little faith sharing group in which people can have a sense of community and comradeship. One of the greatest mistakes we make is to cut oneself off from the other people in the church. In your doubt and grief, you walk alone. The Annunciation of the Lord

This year 2024, the Annunciation of the Lord will be observed on Monday, April 8. This change in date is due to the fact that March 25, which is traditionally the day of the Annunciation, falls during Holy Week.

During Holy Week, the focus is on the sufferings of Jesus before His death and the upcoming Easter celebration, so these take precedence over the Annunciation. The Annunciation commemorates the moment when Jesus became incarnate in the womb of the Virgin Mary after she consented, as related in Luke 1:26-38
